

Trafficking Bills 2020

Due to the COVID-19 virus, the Legislature has recessed until at least May 4. It is unclear what the procedures will be for the balance of the 2020 session, given that a key policy committee [deadlines](#) will have already passed. It is likely that number of bills that to be heard will be reduced and deadlines adjusted as needed. We just don't know at this point. Below is the current status of each trafficking-related measure and live links to each bill for further information.
